Referring to 32 Vic. ch. 21, we find section 4-of ch. 10 R. S. O. , substantially the same as section 2 of this Act. We note that no section of this Act provides for the recovery of any penalty except the general provision in section 77, which is consolidated in chapter 10 R. S. O. , as section 182. We further find section 2 taken from chapter 6 of the Consol. Stats. 0. , section-1. By sub-section 2 of section 1 of chapter...
